Mahon and Cody describe a 14 year old girl with Turner's syndrome who developed benign intracranial hypertension following commencement of growth hormone therapy. It is postulated that the growth hormone activates the choroid plexus. She was initially treated with serial lumbar punctures under general anaesthesia but ultimately required the insertion of a ventriculoperitoneal shunt.
