VOLUNTEER RESPONDENTS REQUIRED FOR CHILDHOOD CANCER RESEARCH

We are a language training and language research business involved in Linguistic Validation for major life science customers, now seeks volunteers to pilot test a language questionnaire in the area of childhood cancer research.

These interviews are for the paediatric PRO-CTCAE, an instrument owned by the National Cancer Institute (NCI), the US federal government's principal agency for cancer research and training. Below is a link with more info on the instrument.

We need 8 families with children/teens aged 7-17 who have received cancer treatment within the last 6 months to assess the English language of a lifestyle questionnaire related to childhood cancer.

This is a phone/zoom call questionnaire where respondents are asked their understanding of the language used and can suggest any appropriate changes. One questionnaire is for the parent and one for the child/teen. Respondents receive an immediate incentive of £70 each (2 x £70 per family pair). The questionnaire is typically 30 to 40 minutes long.

There are no right or wrong answers, we simply need feedback on the language content through our trained interviewers. Respondents must be resident in the UK or NI and be first language English speakers. Consent and privacy forms will apply. We have already conducted a first round of interviews and now need new respondents for this second round.
