**Wyong Hospital** is an acute major metropolitan hospital with over 300 beds providing inpatient, outpatient and emergency services to residents in the northern region of the Central Coast.

**Gosford Hospital** is the principal referral hospital and trauma centre for the Central Coast, with over 500 inpatient beds and 24/7 access to the emergency department and operating theatres.

**Wyong Hospital and Gosford Hospitals** have busy mixed **Emergency Departments** with a wide variety of presentations including good exposure to trauma and paediatrics. Both are well supported by committed emergency physicians and a junior medical workforce with a tight team that is highly procedurally focused.

Our **General Medicine** teams are headed by Staff Specialists and Visiting Medical Officers (VMOs) and supported with Trainees, Residents, and Interns. Rotations can include: General Medicine, Geriatric Medicine, Rehabilitation Medicine, Medical Assessment Unit, Cardiology, Emergency, Cardiology, Neurology, Gastroenterology and Medical Oncology and ICU.
