<u>Postmenopausal Bleeding: Incidence of Endometrial Pathology with Endometrial Thickness of</u> 3mm-3.9mm

Treacy et al reviewed the investigations for women with postmenopausal bleeding. There were 42 patients with an endometrial thickness 3.0-3.9mm on ultrasound. On subsequent biopsy none had carcinoma. The authors state that if the endometrial thickness is <4mm, further investigation may not be necessary.

An Observational Study of proximity between Community Mental Health Facilities and Off-Licenses and Bookmakers in Dublin

Wong studied the proximity between community mental health facilities (CMHFs) and off-licences and bookmaker premises. There were 123 off-licences and 47 bookmakers within 1 Km walking distance from the CMHFs.

Analysis of the trend in Oral Anticoagulation Overdose

Ali et al. report that there were 465 oral anticoagulant enquiries between 2010 and 2020. There were 166 therapeutic related errors in elderly patients. Accidental ingestion, 218 cases, were most frequently encountered in toddlers.
