<u>Hepatitis B related hepatocellular carcinoma: Screening, screening and more screening</u>

Sopena-Falco et al report on 847 cases of hepatocellular carcinoma, of whom 39 had associated hepatitis B. Only 4.6% of the patients had associated hepatitis B infection. During the study period, 71% of the patients died.

Review of Outcomes for Vaginal-Approach Cervical Cerclage in Women at Risk of Spontaneous Preterm Birth

O'Keefe et al report on 62 women who had a cervical cerclage performed prior to 24 weeks gestation. The authors report that the procedure is associated with a number of complications including vaginal bleeding, PPROM, infection, and difficulty in suture removal.
