<p>Increasing Influenza vaccination uptake rates in the &gt;65-year-old population</p> <p>O’Tuathail et al report that the proportion of patients over 65 years who received the flu vaccine in 2018 was 53%. Following the introduction of a vaccination awareness programme the uptake increased to 68% in 2018/19.</p>	805
<p>Longitudinal audit of outcomes subsequent to teriparatide therapy</p> <p>Rafferty et al describe the use of Teriparatide in a cohort of patents with osteoporosis. Ninety one per cent had a previous fracture. After starting Teriparatide 58% had no further fractures. Among those who had a subsequent fracture, the majority were non-vertebral.</p>	806
<p>The Learning Effects of Within-unit Handover Report</p> <p>Duff et al made video-recordings of medical handovers. The mean duration was 33 mins, and the mean number of participants was 21. The authors conclude that it is a powerful learning tool.</p>	807

<p>Medical and social needs of pregnant asylum-seekers in Direct Provision</p> <p>Lee et al. describe the challenges faced by 50 pregnant women in direct provision. The problems included HIV infection, unplanned pregnancy, late booking, and poor social supports.</p>	808
<p>Challenges associated with Global Bariatric Medical Tourism</p> <p>Dhannoon et al. report on 4 cases of bariatric surgery performed abroad which were followed by major complications after returning home. The authors suggest that there should be a registry of patients who have had bariatric surgery abroad to ensure that they receive prompt post-operative care if required.</p>	809
<p>A Comparison of Arthroplasty Activity Nationally between Mixed and Elective-Only Units</p>	810
<p>Luck of the Microbiologist – A Retrospective Observational Cohort Study</p> <p>Ali and Ryan describe the workloads undertaken by individual HCWs in a busy microbiology department. The outcomes examined were the number of significant blood cultures and Cov-2 managed per HCW.</p>	811
<p>Haematoma following thyroid surgery, reducing the incidence in the face of anticoagulant &amp; antiplatelet use</p> <p>O’Keefe et al. report on 292 patients who underwent thyroidectomy. The haematoma rate was 0.68% (1/292). The authors describe the use of Floseal.</p>	812
<p>Sustained Virological Response Rates following Hepatitis C treatment with Direct-Acting Antivirals in patients with Decompensated Liver Cirrhosis</p>	813
