Teh et al. found that among their patients with end-stage kidney disease, the prevalence of erectile dysfunction was 96% in the haemodialysis patients and 63% in the transplant group.	
Autistic traits at neurodevelopmental assessment for very preterm infants	828
Hayden et al. describe the follow-up of a cohort of 96 preterm infants. Twenty two (23%) showed clinical features of autism, the majority being male.	
Medical management of miscarriage: Old versus new regimens	829
Kumari et al. found that among 127 patients with a miscarriage, Mifepristone + Misoprostol was more successful than Misoprostal only, 89.3% vs 73.2%.	
Estimated prevalence of HIV among Ukrainian refugees Hanrahan and Barrett estimate that there are 509 Ukrainian refugees living with HIV in Ireland. This needs to factored	830

Patient Knowledge About Prescribed Medication in Older Adults  Ali et al. studied 130 patients and their understanding about their medications. Their knowledge was sub-optimal, 88 could not recall any doses, and 111 were unaware of the major side-effects.	831
Severe Maternal Morbidity and the Impact of the Covid Pandemic  Sayegh et al. report that the severe maternal morbidity rate fell 50% in the initial 2 years of the Covid pandemic. One of the factors may have the avoidance of pregnancy by women with co-morbidities.	832
Investigation of fertility awareness amongst Obstetrics and Gynaecology and General Practice trainees  Stokes and Petch et al. have surveyed knowledge of and attitudes to fertility care and Assisted Reproductive Technologies (ART) between trainees working in Obstetrics & Gynaecology and General Practice trainees in Ireland.	833
Neonatal Abstinence Syndrome: A National Survey Tamgumus et al. have surveyed the management of NAS nationally. All units use Oromorph and 66% use Phenobarbitone as a second line medication. 66% have a non-pharmacological plan, and 24% provide specific parent education.	834
Smoking is an independent risk factor for skin flap complications following inguinal lymph node dissection for penile cancer  Muheilan et al. report on 24 cases of penile cancer. The complication of skin flat necrosis was more common among patients who smoked.	835

Wong et al. found that 50 pre-heart failure patients reported at least one additional unhealthy behaviour in the 'life's simple 7' during Covid.	
Loneliness amongst Older Hospital Inpatients: Prevalence and Associated Factors	838
Maden et al. surveyed 107 inpatients. Half reported some degree of loneliness and 1 in 7 reported higher degrees of loneliness.

Ralph et al. report that the priority of a referral can be triaged by an accompanying image. In a series of 51 cases, 4 patients were upgraded, 24 were deescalated, and 23 remained the same.
